


### HIGH SCHOOL OUTREACH PROGRAM

The War on Melanoma's mission is to eliminate melanoma related-deaths in Oregon through access to education, awareness, early detection and prevention strategies.



million new diagnosis expected in 2022\*





#### **Early Detection**

- 1. How to self-skin exam
- 2. Normal vs. Abnormal moles
- 3. ABCDE criteria for moles

#### Prevention

- 1. Sun safety
- 2. Health behaviors
- 3. Sunscreen
