Program Benefits

- A 4-week visiting rotation at <u>Doernbecher Children's Hospital</u>
- A \$3,000 stipend for travel, housing, and application expenses
- An assigned faculty mentor
- A resident or fellow near-peer mentor
- A personal meeting with the Residency Program Director
- An offer to interview for a position in our pediatric residency program

About Doernbecher Children's Hospital

Doernbecher is a tertiary care children's hospital that serves as the primary referral for Oregon and Southwest Washington, and parts of Idaho, Alaska, and Northern California. We are consistently ranked the top children's hospital in Oregon, with seven specialties ranking in the top 50 nationally; we hold a magnet designation by the ANCC (American Nurses Credentialing Center) ensuring the best patient outcomes are delivered with a collaborative, interprofessional team of experts; and have been verified as a Level 1 Pediatric Trauma Center and Surgery Site.

How to Apply

- Criteria: Persons who have experienced significant disadvantage or adversity
 (i.e., a first-generation college graduate; a recipient of social service resources
 while in elementary or secondary school, enhanced education or other
 programs for diverse populations; or by experience of economic, cultural,
 educational, or family adversity).
- Visit the OHSU MD program site for visiting students; applicants must meet all listed requirements.
- Review the <u>Department of Pediatrics Visiting Student site</u> for rotation options.
- Submit an application for an OHSU pediatric visiting rotation through VSLO.
