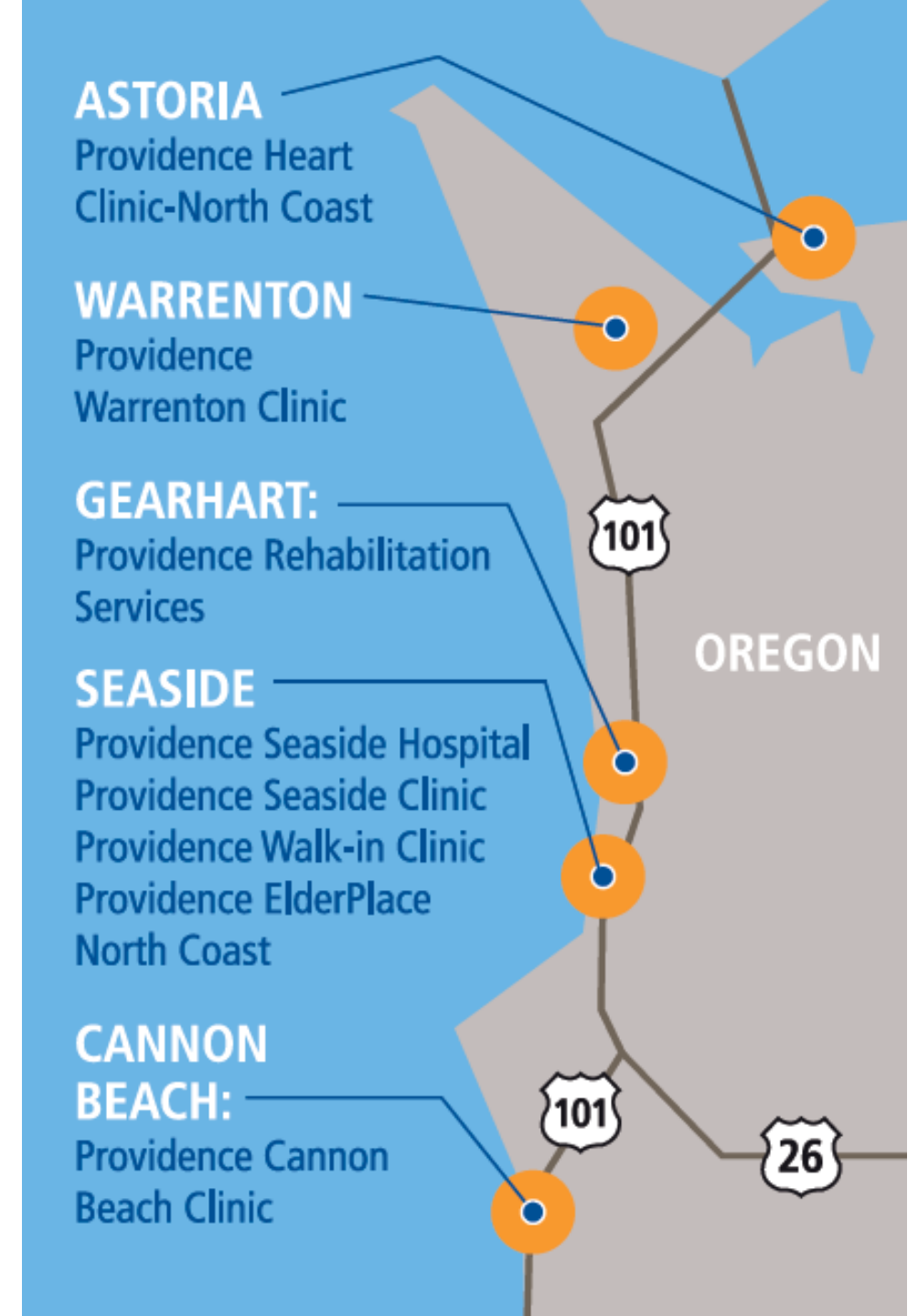

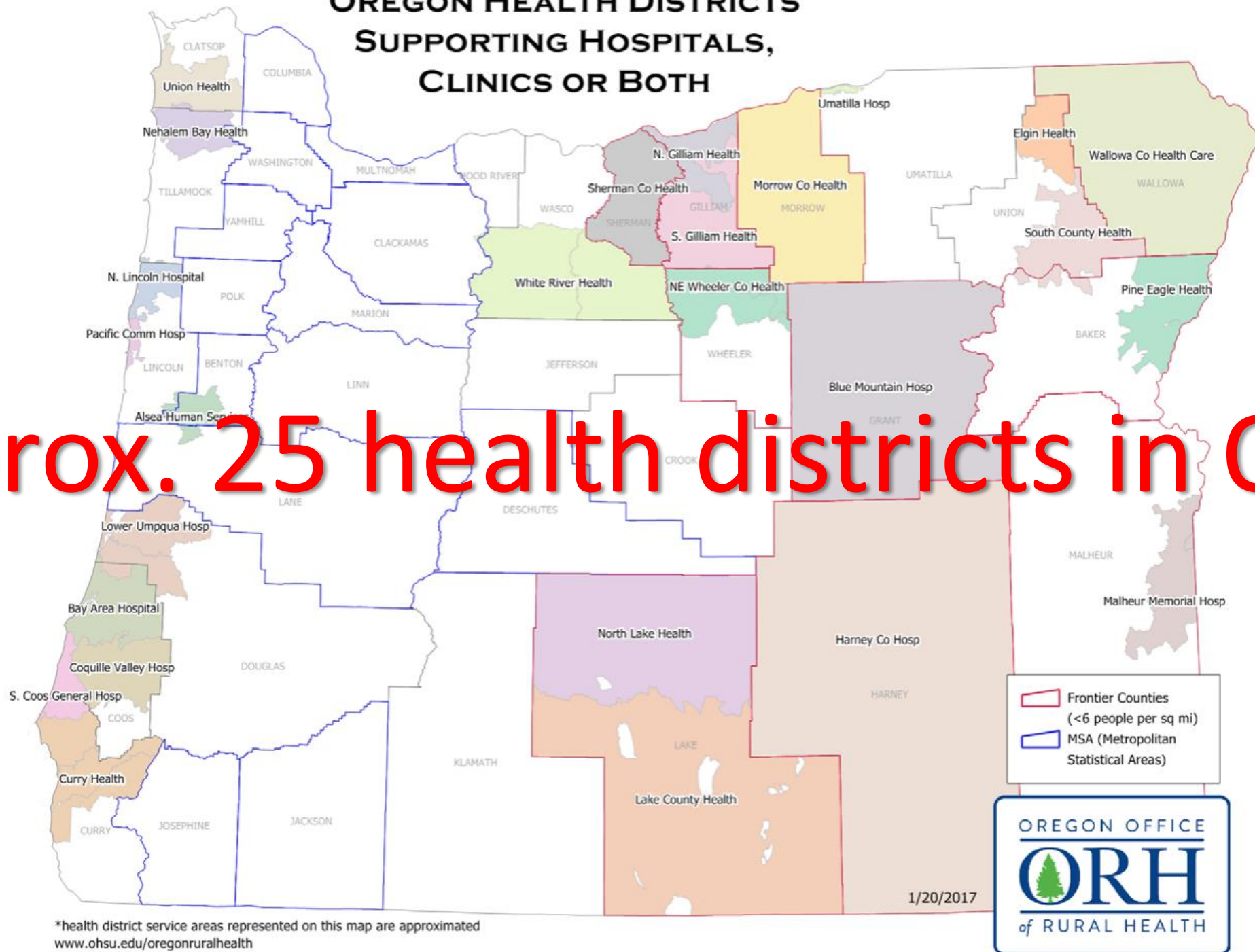
Providence North Coast Service Area

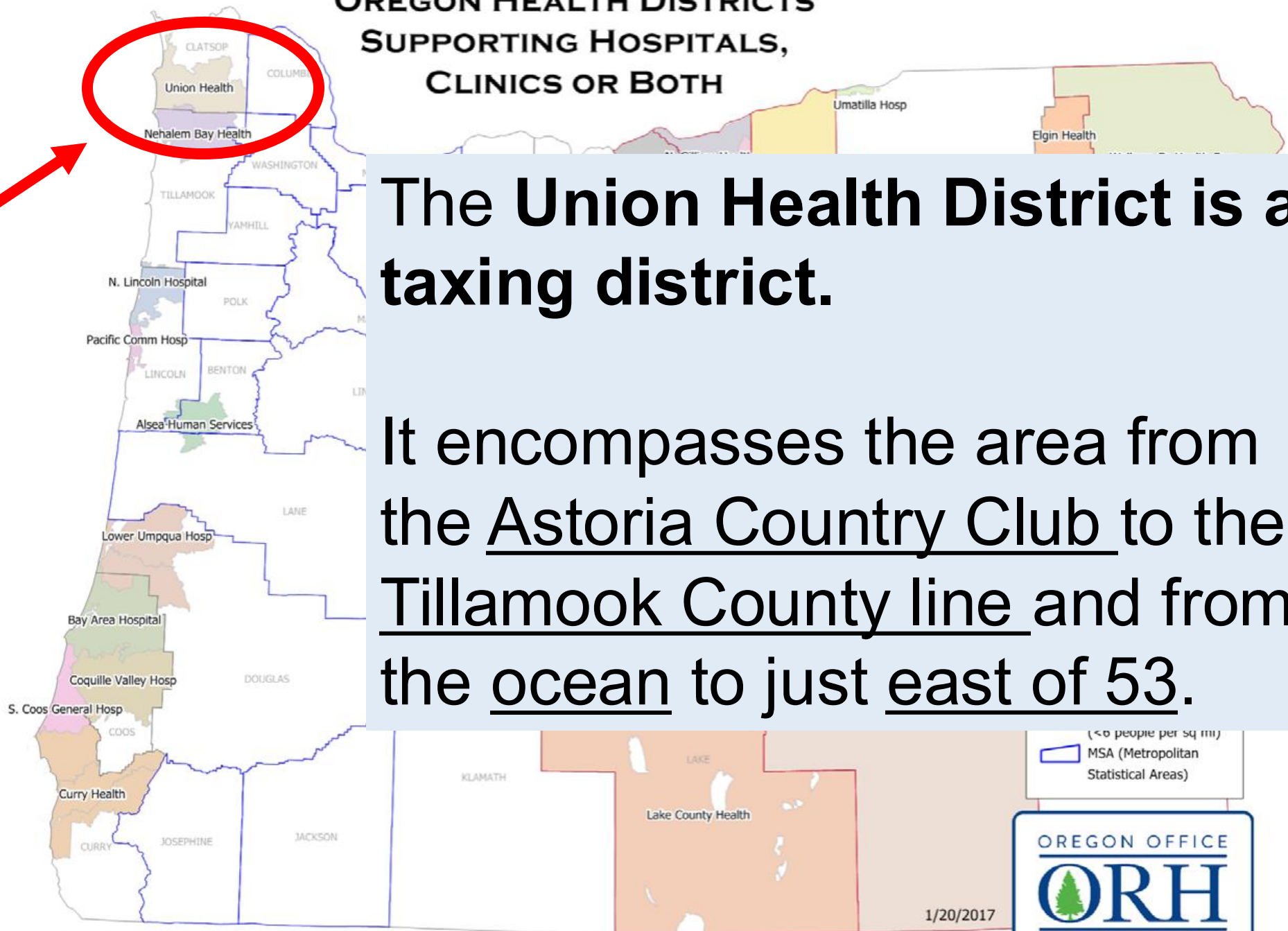
OREGON HEALTH DISTRICTS SUPPORTING HOSPITALS, CLINICS OR BOTH

The Union Health District is a taxing district.

It encompasses the area from the Astoria Country Club to the Tillamook County line and from the ocean to just east of 53.

Union Health District History

- **In 1964**, the Union Health District was established under the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 440, for the specific purpose of assuring the residents of the area that there would **continue to be a hospital in the Seaside area**.
- In 1968, the UHD Board asked the taxpayers to **pass a bond to provide funds to construct a new hospital at 725 S. Wahanna Rd.**
- **In 1970**, the new **Seaside General Hospital** was opened.
- **In 1981**, UHD partnered with **Providence** who assumed the **operations** and management of Seaside General Hospital.

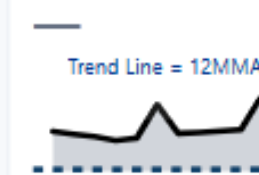
- System reports tracking several key measures

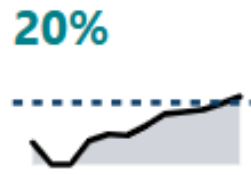

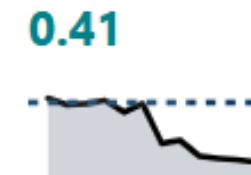
